

# Struggling to Get Unemployment Benefits? Here's What You Need to Know.

## The Virginia Employment Commission (VEC) has been ordered to end its unemployment insurance backlog.

On May 25, 2021, Judge Henry Hudson of the U.S. District Court, Eastern District of Virginia ordered the VEC to end the backlog of unpaid unemployment insurance claims and identify and pay Virginians whose benefits were improperly terminated while their cases awaited adjudication. **The VEC now has until Labor Day to resolve the entire backlog.** 

#### What does this mean for me?

Hundreds of thousands of Virginians should get relief within the next few months. For example, for those waiting for deputy adjudications, the VEC has been ordered to issue at least 10,000 adjudications per week by July 1, and at least 20,000 per week by August 1. The VEC has also been ordered to effectively eliminate the backlog of claims waiting for deputy adjudication by Labor Day.
