COLLEGE STUDENTS

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN HIGHER EDUCATION AT LEAST PART TIME MUST MEET ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SNAP BENEFITS.

EXEMPTIONS:

- 17 YEARS OR YOUNGER, OR 50 YEARS OR OLDER;
- MENTALLY OR PHYSICALLY UNFIT TO WORK;
- EMPLOYED 20 OR MORE HOURS A WEEK;
- PARTICIPATE IN A STATE OR FEDERALLY FUNDED WORK STUDY PROGRAM;
- RESPONSIBLE FOR A DEPENDENT UNDER 6, A DEPENDENT BETWEEN 6-11 AND NOT HAVE ADEQUATE CHILDCARE, OR ARE A FULL TIME STUDENT WHO IS A SINGLE PARENT/CARETAKER OF A CHILD UNDER 12;
- RECEIVING TANF BENEFITS OR PARTICIPATING IN TANF'S VIRGINIA INITIATIVE FOR EDUCATION AND WORK (VIEW).

EXEMPTIONS CONTINUED:

- PARTICIPATING THROUGH ON THE JOB TRAINING; OR
- PLACED IN HIGHER LEARNING THROUGH
 - PROGRAMS UNDER WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT (WIOA);
 - SNAP EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING (SNAPET)
 - PART OF A CAREER OR TECHNICAL PROGRAM THAT MEETS CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS;
 - A PROGRAM UNDER SECTION 236 OF THE TRADE ACT; OR
 - AN EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM OPERATED BY STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WHERE ONE OR MORE OF THE PROGRAM'S COMPONENTS ARE COMPARABLE TO SNAPET COMPONENTS.
